NÁQUERA-(Valencia) Spain



- **Firearms.** A copy of A2 Individual Firearms Declaration must be held by each shooter when arrives into Spain.
The arms must be included in the shooter European Firearms Permit (EFP).
In case the arms are not included in EFP, each shooter should bring with him a National Federation Certificate in an official Federation paper in which it says that he is the owner of the arms he takes with,
A model of this letter could be;
XXX Shooting Federation certifies that Mr/Ms..... Is the owner of the following arms:
 - (Describing the same arms as A2 says. One sheet per person)
 -This letter should be signed by the President or the Secretary General and be stamped.
- **Delegations Attention Office:** Will be open on Sunday the 06th, from 16.⁰⁰ to 20.⁰⁰ hrs.
- **Powder and Caps** will be given on Monday morning the 7th at Náquera Shooting Range only to the Team's Captain, and according to the F2 Final Powder and Caps Requirements Form sending to the RFEDETO.
- **Transportation** for Opening Ceremony (8th September) and Closing Dinner (12th September). If a National Team is interested in a bus for these two days, Organising Committee has arranged the transport for both places. Please ask for conditions and prices to Organising Committee.
- **Insurance.** Organising Committee could provide for a Sport Accident Insurance during the training time or during the Competition. It covers only sport accident during the time you spend in Shooting Ranges. In case you are interested in please ask for the price to Organising Committee.
- **Flags and Anthem.** Each National Federation must bring two National Flags and a CD with a short version (40-50 seconds) of the National Anthem, and must be given at the Competition Office.
